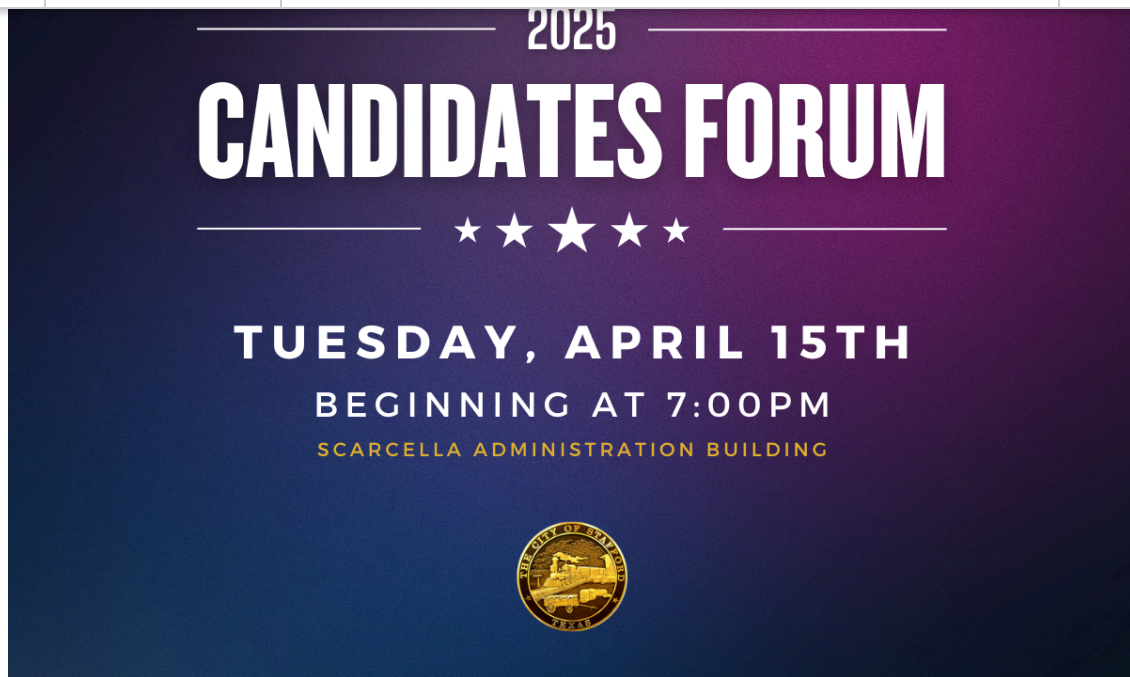

Hello Stafford,

The City of Stafford operates on sales tax rather than a city property tax as you know.

People often see the warehouses and other large companies as our sales tax collectors. Some of these collect taxes, and some do not. We don't always see the small square footage business offices tucked away in office buildings or strip malls. Some of these businesses collect sales tax on the type of business conducted, which can be substantial.

We have recently had an increase in new businesses reporting sales tax. These companies may be small in footprint but they collect large amounts of tax for the product or service provided. We welcome all businesses that create jobs or add to our quality of life. You don't have to be big and flashy to make an impact on sales tax revenue. Sometimes you can have a small footprint and not be recognized on a day-to-day basis.

There are many ongoing projects that continue to move forward. For instance:

- Pike road reconstruction is nearing completion and will improve cross-town mobility.
- The Target Store at the Grid is under construction and is visibly taking shape.
- The Grid developer will be at our March SEDC meeting to discuss updated plans.
- A thoroughfare maintenance road project will be discussed at the March meeting.
